General Information:

- No refund of entry fees will be made.
- No dogs allowed on the showground during the show except for guide or assistance dogs or dogs entered in the dog section or used in approved displays.

Judging:

- All decisions of the judge's will be final.
- All exhibitors are requested to refrain from conversing with the judge/s during judging unless they are asked to do so.

Entry to the Showground:

Only Exhibitors, handlers and authorised officials are permitted to attend. No members of the public are allowed on the Showground. DGSA members wishing to attend MUST contact the Show Organiser, Brett Gleeson by email (manager@maitlandshowground.com.au) to request permission to attend.

Vehicular access is permitted **VIA LOUTH PARK ROAD ENTRANCE** for the delivery and collection of your exhibit(s). Once unloaded, please remove your vehicle to the designated parking area. In the event of rain, the Cattle Pavilion will be used for judging.

COVID SAFE REQUIREMENTS:

A COVID Safe plan has been prepared and submitted by the HRA&HA to NSW Health. Approval is pending. You will be required to adhere to the COVID Safe plan and follow the instructions provided by the Showground Manager, Showground Officials and Marshalls. If you fail to follow the instructions given, you may be removed from the Showground. The COVID Safe practices will include- all attendees registering with the QR code upon arrival, hand sanitising (provided), social distancing and any other practices directed or recommended by NSW Health at the time of the show, including the wearing of masks and gloves.

- ENTRY FEE: \$3.00 Per animal per class or group class.
- LATE ENTRIES: will be accepted on the day of judging up to 9am. HOWEVER A LATE ENTRY FEE OF \$3 PER ANIMAL PER CLASS WILL APPLY.
- JUDGING - 9.30 am on Sunday 21st FEBRUARY 2021.
- All goats to be on the ground and penned by 9.00 am on judging day.
- ENTRIES CLOSE: 5pm MONDAY 15th FEBRUARY 2021.
- All classes may be divided at the Judge's discretion in consultation with the Chief Steward.
- Entry to Showground - please use **THE GATE ON LOUTH PARK ROAD, MAITLAND.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All animals to be judged under DGSA & DGA rules and the Hunter River A & H Assoc Ltd Rules and Regulations, as well as being registered with appropriate bodies.
2. Owner to provide scanner.
3. All entries must stand as entered, however additional entries are allowed.
4. ~~Five or more animals entered and pre-paid by one exhibitor by the closing date, will be allocated 1 free gate pass.~~
5. Dustcoats or clothing carrying insignias or markings that may identify the exhibitor must not be worn by attendants parading exhibits before a judge. **No stud signs permitted to be displayed prior to the start of judging.**
6. Exhibitors are requested to refrain from conversing with judge during judging, unless asked to do so.
7. All stock must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor, except in specified group classes.
8. Goats entered in **any group or progeny class** or special class **must** be entered in the **respective age class**.
9. All goats attending shows must be negative for C.A.E.V; show no symptoms of Mycoplasmosis, Mastitis, Caseous Lymphadenitis, and no obvious signs of external or internal parasites. No goats may be exhibited at Maitland Show unless from a stud/property for which a Johne's Disease Declaration has been submitted with the entry form.
10. **C.A.E. Regulations:** Separate pens will be provided for C.A.E. free animals, on production of a **current vet's certificate (certificates not to be more than 6 months old)** as proof. Please state on entry form if separate pens are required.
11. **Footrot Regulations:** Any animals coming from a quarantined property or areas of the state must produce proof of disease-free flocks and **all entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor.**
