CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The work submitted must be the original work of the entrant and must have been completed in the past two years (2) to February 2024 and not have been shown at any previous Maitland Show.
2. All entrants must complete the official entry form on line and pay the entry fee of \$15 (including GST) for each entry www.maitlandshowground.com.au. Please print out the entry form when delivering the artworks.
3. Entries close on Wednesday 24th January 2024.
4. Entrants are limited to **one work only in each section** and should clearly indicate the section in which the work is to be shown. Because of limited hanging space, total size framed should not exceed the sections maximum sizes except where permitted.
5. All entries will be for sale unless the artist makes a request for an artwork to be excluded. 20% commission on the Gross sale price including GST is payable to the Hunter River Agriculture & Horticulture Association (HRA&HA)
6. GST WILL BE CHARGED ON ALL SALES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ARTISTS' GST STATUS. (PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR ABN Number or a reason for not quoting your GST status (eg. Hobby Artist etc.) on the Entry Form.
7. Entries must be suitably framed – No photo or poster frames allowed. Unframed canvases may be permitted although works deemed to be unsuitably framed will be rejected
8. Artwork must be “ready to hang” with D rings, and art standard cord/wire attached.
9. All works must be clean, and glass cleaned so that the work can be hung immediately it is received. Work that is wet will not be excepted.
10. Unframed canvases are permitted. Works that would normally be framed and are unsuitably framed will be rejected.
11. Labels must be affixed to the back of the work with the following information:
12. Artist’s Name, address, email address, mobile phone number, title, section entered, medium & price.
13. All transport costs and insurance are to be met by the artist, The greatest possible care will be taken, however no liability will be accepted by the HRA&HA for damage during the show and while in our care.
14. The HR&HA and the Art Show Chief Steward, will not be bound to hang all entries due to limited space. The judge will view all entries.
15. .
16. Artists must ensure that all entries are in line with Copyright and Plagiarism laws.
17. The judge’s decision is **final**, and no correspondence will be entered into.
18. The HRA&HA and the Art Show committee reserves the right to have any of the works reproduced on all media platforms. For publicity purposes.
19. Entries shall be addressed to the Maitland Art Prize, deliveries to the Thomas Morgan Pavilion, Maitland Showground entrance, Bloomfield Street, south Maitland on Monday 5th February between 7.30 am & 12 noon.
20. Judging and opening at 6pm on Wednesday 7th February 2024.
21. All works to be collected on Sunday 18th February between 4pm-5pm. Or Monday 19th February between 10am – 2pm.
