CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR ALL ENTRANTS

1. The Judge's decision is final. Photographs not conforming to the Condition of Entry are not eligible for judging.
2. Junior - Being of school age (under 18) as of the first day of Show.
3. No responsibility will be assumed by Maitland Show, although all due care will be taken.
4. The judge reserves the right to reject any entry which is not considered to be satisfactory. Where there are only 1 or 2 entrants in a section, First and Second place will only be awarded if the photographs are of First and Second place quality.
5. Entries must be lodged online at <https://maitlandshowground.com.au/> by the due date of 09/02/2024.
6. All photos must be wrapped in brown paper, bubble wrap or in a protective envelope for protection when brought to the Show Office. Each exhibitor is to submit photographs in one package with the NAME CLEARLY written on the package. Please bring a copy of your ENTRY FORM to accompany your entry to ensure the correct entrants are credited for their work.
7. Collection of entries is the Monday - Friday following the show between 9am-2pm, entries to be returned via post must include return postage with entry.
8. All photographs must have been taken by the exhibitors as an amateur or hobbyist. All photos must be original works and must have not won a prize at any previous Maitland Show.
9. Photographs can be edited to enhance the photo but not manipulated, they can be captured using digital technology or film.
10. Photographers who have had an acceptance in a past or current Salons are not eligible.
11. Maximum size of photographs to be A4, excluding borders. Minimum size is 10x15cm postcard size.
12. Photographs must be mounted on STIFF BLACK CARDBOARD so there is a border of approx. 1cm all round.
13. Photograph titles must appear on the bottom border.
14. The exhibitor's name and the class must be on the back of the cardboard.
15. An exhibitor may enter up to 2 prints in each class.
16. An entry may only consist of 1 photograph and must be mounted ready for display.

Zero Tolerance to Abuse
