Condition of entry for competitors:


This section will be run under the by-laws and regulations of the Association, such regulations and by-laws are available for inspection at the Association's Office.

- 1. Properly broken in to lead & tie up. Committee has the right to eliminate an animal that does not comply with all Association's regulations.
- 2. ALL CATTLE IN SHED BY 7.00am Saturday morning. (Cattle can arrive from Thursday & leave on Saturday evening)
- 3. Cattle to be judged and paraded Saturday 17 February 2024
- 4. Judging to commence approx. at 8.00am. (This may vary due to HEAT)
- 5. The age of all cattle to be actual age up to 28/2/24
- 6. Entries close 10th February 2024 and entry fees must accompany all entries. Late Entries May Incur an Extra Fee
- 7. ENTRY FEE \$10 PER HEAD.
- 8. Further particulars regarding BREED, AGE, PEDIGREE, NAME OF EXHIBIT, CLASS No and EXHIBITORS NAME or STUD must be given on Entry Form.
- 9. All cattle must be registered with their recognized Breed Societies.
- 10. Beef Cattle must be haltered and all bulls over 12 months of age must have a nose ring fitted.
- 11. All cows or heifers 2½ years old and over must have had a calf eligible to be registered with the relevant Breed Society, within the last 12 months, or be verified by a Veterinary Certificate.
- 12. A calf under 9 months of age may parade with its mother in the cow classes.
- 13. Prizes and Prize money will be allocated according to sponsorship. Prize money may be collected immediately after classes are judged.
- 14. Any cattle wishing to be housed together with another Exhibitor, please advise on entry form.
- 15. All exhibitors must hand in an NVD/TSS form upon arrival to stewards of the Cattle Committee
- 16. The minimum age for leading bulls in the general beef classes is 12 years of age as at the date of the show, unless otherwise stipulated.

Zero Tolerance to Abuse

Aggressive behaviour and any form of verbal or physical abuse towards staff, members, volunteers, competitors or guests will not be tolerated. Anyone engaging in inappropriate behaviour at the Maitland Showground will be asked to change their behaviour, issued a formal warning, removed from the grounds or from entering the grounds.
