5. No more than three entries in each class per exhibitor. Each entry can only be entered in one class.
6. All exhibits to be made within the last 18 months and not to have been exhibited at a previous Maitland Show, and to be primarily work of the entrant.
7. Junior and Youth entrants are allowed to use adult assistance for hazardous activities.
8. Judges and MWG committee may issue additional special prizes on judging day (e.g. tied first prize, class project, or exceptional work when compared to entrant's peers and/or not strictly meeting category requirements) or re-allocate entries to more appropriate sections

Zero Tolerance to Abuse

WOODWORK

- 8500 WW1 - Any turned wooden item turned on a faceplate or chuck.
- 8501 WW2 - Any wooden platter or bowl (not necessarily turned)
- 8502 WW3 - Any wooden item turned between centres/spindle.
- 8503 WW4 - Any wooden box not turned.
- 8504 WW5 - Any wooden toy or puzzle.
- 8505 WW6 - Any miniature items, a set of two or more.(e.g. dolls house furniture, figures, animals)
- 8506 WW7 - Pens hand turned (max of 2 pens per entry).Pens will be displayed on common stands not in boxes. Pens will be displayed on common stands not in boxes
- 8507 WW8 - Any wooden item-not turned.e.g., scroll saw, marquetry, intarsia, carved item etc.
