



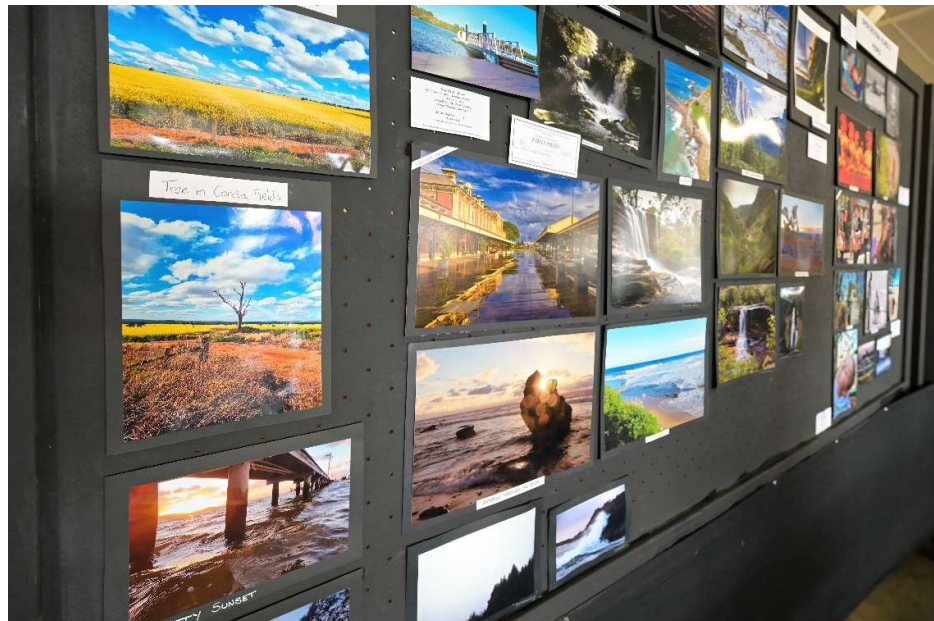

Exhibitors Notes

- Prizes that are items they must be picked up along with the collection of your photographs after the show.
- Entries can be collected from the Maitland Show office the week following the Show between 9am-2pm Monday to Friday. Entries cannot be collected on Sunday afternoon (16/02/2025) without prior notice to the chief steward.
- Those exhibitors who wish their entries to be returned by mail must have a pre-paid satchel or reusable packing including return postage in the form of stamps.
- If there are large volumes of entries not all photos can be displayed due to space constraints, it is the judge's and chief steward's decision on what photographs are to be displayed.

Exhibitors Rules - Conditions of Entry for All Entrants

1. The Judge's decision is final. Photographs not conforming to the Conditions of Entry are not eligible for judging. The judge and chief steward reserve the right to reject any entry not considered satisfactory. Where there are only 1 or 2 entrants in a section, First and Second place will only be awarded if the photographs are of First and Second place quality.
2. No responsibility will be assumed by Maitland Show, although all due care whilst handling and processing your entries.
3. All photographs are to be taken by the exhibitors as amateur or hobbyist photographers. To be an amateur photographer you must not make an income off your photography. All photos must be original works that have not placed at any previous Maitland Show (1st, 2nd, 3rd, Champion and Reserve Champion). Photographers who have had an entry acceptance in past or present Maitland International Salon of Photography competitions are not eligible.
4. If there are large volumes of entries not all photos can be displayed due to space constraints, it is the judge's and chief steward's decision on what photographs are to be displayed.
5. The school section is judged as a whole school based on the overall quality of the images submitted by each school, not individual students. Prizes for the Champion, Reserve Champion and Highly Commended School go to the school, not individual students, it is up to the school how they distribute the prize received.
6. Photographs can be edited to enhance the photo; they can be captured using digital technology or film.
7. Photos must be no larger than 21cm x 29.7cm (A4 / 8.3" x 11.7") and mounted on or behind light-weight to medium-weight BLACK CARDBOARD ONLY, with maximum borders on the top and both sides of no more than 2.5cm (1"), with a wider border of 3.8cm (1.5") on the bottom, to allow room for the title. ALL photos must be titled to assist with judging.
8. Entries must be submitted via Showday Online and close Friday 31/01/2025. Photographs are to be handed in on Saturday 01/02/2025 between 9am-2pm in the Tea Pot Café pavilion (drop off before this date can be arranged), any entries that are handed in after 01/02/2025 will not be accepted. Private judging will be held on Sunday the 2nd of February.
9. All photos must be wrapped in brown paper, bubble wrap, or a protective envelope. Each exhibitor is to submit photographs in one package with the NAME CLEARLY written on the package. Please bring a copy of your ENTRY FORM to accompany your entry to ensure the correct entrants are credited for their work.
10. Exhibits must be clearly labelled with printed entry tags, name & class number placed on the MIDDLE BACK of the photo, so the Stewards can place the velcro tabs on the corners for display.
11. An exhibitor may enter up to 2 prints in each class and must be mounted and ready to put on display.
12. Collection of entries is the Monday - Friday following the show between 9am-2pm, entries to be returned via post must include return postage with entry. Entries cannot be collected on Sunday afternoon (16/02/2025) without prior notice to the chief steward.
