Exhibitors Notes/Rules

- Exhibitors wishing to enter the showground during show hours, will pay normal gate prices, unless otherwise specified in this schedule.

- Exhibitors are only permitted to enter two (2) entries per class.
- Beeswax Block – weight requirements – 500g to 1kg block
- Exhibits must be the bona fide production of the exhibitor's apiary.
- Exhibits that fail to meet the requirements of any class will not be placed on display or judged.

CLASSES 7201 TO 7207

Exhibits in classes 7201 – 7207 must be presented for judging in a standard 500g/375ml round glass jar with a white 63mm plastic or metal lid. (Not tamper proof)

LIQUID HONEY

- 7201 LIQUID HONEY - Light Colour
- 7202 LIQUID HONEY - Medium Colour
- 7203 LIQUID HONEY - Dark Colour

CHAMPION LIQUID HONEY (Classes 7201 – 7203) Ribbon

FLOWFRAME HONEY

- 7204 FLOWFRAME HONEY – any colour - Honey extracted from a flow frame

YOUTH BEEKEEPER HONEY (Under 18 years)

- 7205 LIQUID HONEY – any colour

CREAMED HONEY

- 7206 CREAMED HONEY

CHUNK HONEY

- 7207 LIQUID CHUNK HONEY- liquid honey containing a piece of comb honey of the same source (measuring at least 40mm by 110mm)

CLASSES 7208 TO 7212

FRAME OF HONEY

- 7208 FRAME OF COMB HONEY (any size) in a sealed display case

NATIVE BEE HONEY

- 7209 LIQUID HONEY extracted from a native bee hive
 - Exhibits must be in the 50g round jar with white lid supplied – please contact Heather Wightman 0429 989 580 to collect your jar.
 - Jars should be filled to the collar of the jar and honey strained prior to filling.

Judging criteria definitions:

Flavour – the initial taste, secondary taste, and any lingering mouthfeel.

Aroma – the scent imparted immediately and soon after opening the jar.
smells of mould and fermentation are undesirable.

Clarity – a measure of contamination from, but not limited to, pollen, dirt tree bark or propolis.

Density – moisture content, measured by a refractometer.

Brightness – a measure of visible bubbles before opening the jar.

BEESWAX

- 7210 **Beeswax Block** – weight requirement – 500g to 1kg block. Shape to be square, round, or rectangular
- 7211 **Moulded Candle** – made from natural beeswax. (Candles will be burnt for 1 hour)
- 7212 **YOUTH (U18) Rolled Candle** – made from beeswax foundation sheet. (Candles will be burnt for 1 hour)

CLASSES 7213 TO 7216

HUMBLE BEE PROJECT – Restricted to registered schools.

Exhibits in classes 7213 – 7215 must be presented for judging in a standard 500g/375ml round glass jar with a white 63mm plastic or metal lid. (Not tamper proof)
